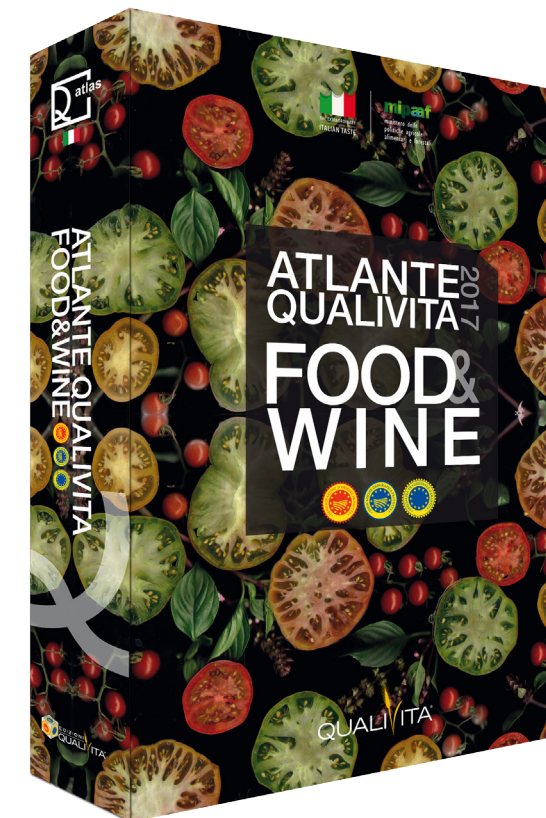

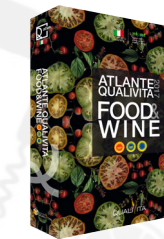

Improvement of the Internet Governance transparency, ICANN's management of generic Top-Level Domains, search engine ranking of GIS and GI information optimization in e-commerce platforms.
